A safety culture is reflected through the behaviour and actions of people. Research shows that a number of complementary behaviour patterns have a very positive impact on the safety culture. This poster provides you with a number of behaviour patterns identified as good safety behaviour.

ASSERTIVENESS

- EXPRESS THOUGHTS, FEELINGS AND BELIEFS
- INFLUENCE EFFECTIVELY, LISTEN AND NEGOTIATE
- ADVISE COLLEAGUES ABOUT POOR SAFETY BEHAVIOUR
- GIVE ON THE JOB FEEDBACK
- ESTABLISH SAFETY DEBRIEFING
- ENSURE CONSTANT COMMUNICATION
- ASK QUESTIONS

FOCUS ON SAFETY

Always remember that safety gets the focus you give it. The way you speak about it and work with it decides its destiny. Safety is never better than the people around it. Any seafarer's behaviour has an impact on the general perception of safety.

PROACTIVENESS

- TAKE TIME TO FIND THE SAFEST SOLUTION

- ENSURE CONTINUAL IMPROVEMENT

- QUESTION REPORTS AND ANALYSES MADE
- GET INVOLVED IN PROBLEM SOLVING PROCESSES
- PRESENT ARGUMENTS, SOLUTIONS AND IDEAS
- BUILD RELATIONSHIPS
- SHOW APPRECIATION TOWARDS SAFE BEHAVIOUR

VISIBILITY

- MAKE SAFETY RESULTS AND EFFORTS VISIBLE
- COMMUNICATE SAFETY GOALS STRATEGY
- MAKE SAFETY KPI'S VISIBLE
- COMMUNICATE SAFETY ACTIVITIES
- ENSURE THAT DECISIONS TAKEN LEAD TO ACTIONS
